OBJECTIVE
To tell a story with images

LESSON # 1

Students will present ten images on poster board that tell a story without words. Students will also be given a visual representation and asked to develop an original story that could be the basis for a film.

Five basic questions should be addressed.

- What is the story about?
- Who are the main characters?
- What are the conflicts?
- What type of film is it?
- How does the film end?

MATERIALS

- 10 PICTURES (PER STUDENT, THEIR CHOICE) FROM ANY SOURCE-PREFER CAMERA OR CAMERA PHONE
- POSTER BOARD
